In accordance with the provisions of the Florida Statutes, notice is hereby given that members of the Historic Preservation Committee will participate in a walk through an area within the City of Gulfport to view historic homes for inclusion in a “Walking Tour Brochure” of the City on Wednesday, March 14, 2012, beginning at 5:00 p.m. The Committee will begin and end their walk at the Gulfport Historical Museum, 5301 28th Avenue South, Gulfport, Florida. The walk is anticipated to take one (1) to one and one-half (1½) hours. The proposed walking route is available by contacting the Office of the City Clerk, 2401 53rd Street South, Gulfport, Florida, 727-893-1012. This workshop meeting is open to the public.

Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Historic Preservation Committee/Certified Local Government with respect to any matter considered at this meeting will need a record of the proceedings and for such purposes may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The law does not require the City Clerk to transcribe verbatim minutes; therefore the applicant must make the necessary arrangements with a private reporter or private reporting firm and bear the resulting expense.
