The Regular Meeting of the City of Gulfport Historic Preservation Committee was held on Wednesday, November 30, 2011, in the Gulfport Historical Museum, 5301 28th Avenue South, Gulfport, Florida.

2. Any other business.


In response to a question by Chairperson Ross on the historic designation of the Casino, Principal Planner Taylor said there was nothing new to report.
