

**Historic Preservation Committee/Certified Local Government  
Meeting Minutes - Wednesday, April 20, 2011**

The Regular Meeting of the City of Gulfport Historic Preservation Committee was held on Wednesday, April 20, 2011, in the Gulfport Historical Museum, 5301 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue South, Gulfport, Florida.
