Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, March 16, 2011

The Regular Meeting of the City of Gulfport Historic Preservation Committee was held on Wednesday, March 16, 2011, in the Gulfport Historical Museum, 5301 28th Avenue South, Gulfport, Florida.

1. Consider approval of the Committee Meeting Minutes of January 19, 2011 and February 16, 2011.

2. Updates:

a. Article XXI of the City Code of Ordinances – Historical Preservation - Amendment.

Chairperson Ross advised that she had met with Community Development Director Fred Metcalf and City Manager Jim O'Reilly to discuss the proposed change to Section 22-21.03 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance. City Manager O'Reilly scheduled Chairperson Ross's presentation to the city council on the proposed change during their workshop meeting of Thursday, May 26. All committee members were asked to attend the workshop meeting. Chairperson Ross spoke on the historical site designation survey which needs to be done for each property within the proposed district.

b. Walking Tour Brochure.

Committee Member Frethem provided information on the prior walking tour documentation she had pulled together. The committee discussed format and tour route. Committee Member Frethem will present details on the new brochure at the April 20, meeting.

3. Any other business.


City Clerk DeMuth mentioned the committee members whose terms were expiring. Council will consider committee appointments during their April 19, meeting.
