

Gulfport Casino Ballroom Decorating Policies



NO TAPE, TACKS, NAILS, SCREWS, HOOKS OR PUSH PINS ARE TO BE USED ON WALLS, PILLARS, POLES, DOORS OR DJ BOOTH.

You may use existing nails, hooks, or ceiling poles to hang or drape things. You may also use a rubbery substance such as tacky tape, or Command products, which will not peel paint off the walls.

NO OPEN CANDLE FLAMES. You may have candles in any type of glass container such as glass votives, floating candles, etc.

No pillars that are not enclosed in a glass container.

NO CANDLES ON THE BAR even if they are in a glass container. Napkins blow around & land on them starting fires.

NO LIVE ANIMALS, including fish. They won't survive & will be belly up before the event starts. It's not a pretty sight!

If you encounter anything about which you have questions, please check with the Casino Supervisor, or Casino staff member.

Clients may lose their security deposit, and be billed for any additional damages if the decorators do not abide by these rules. Please be assured; even with the above mentioned restrictions, there are still a multitude of elegant and memorable decorating possibilities that can be utilized in the Ballroom.
