

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-69

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADVANCED ENGINEERING AND DESIGN, INC. FOR THE PASADENA PLACE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, There are four 48" storm sewer pipes that run from Gulfport Boulevard through the Pasadena Place Subdivision and under the golf course in the Pasadena Yacht and County Club; the pipes are corrugated metal, installed twenty four years ago, and are corroding; and

WHEREAS, The Fiscal Year 2019/2020 Capital improvement Budget provides funding for the Pasadena Place Culvert Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, The estimated cost of the Project is \$600,000; with the city receiving a Senate Appropriation of \$300,000 for construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with Advanced Engineering and Design, Inc., for the preparation of contract documents, permits, bidding, and construction administration services for the Pasadena Place Culvert Replacement Project in the amount of \$78,336.15.

Section 2.

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Grant Agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection for the Culvert Replacement Project and approves a Budget Amendment as attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 3.

This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
