

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO ACCOUNT FOR REVENUES RECEIVED FROM FEMA IN THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, AS A RESULT OF HURRICANE IRMA AND HURRICANE MICHAEL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Governor Rick Scott issued Executive Order 17-235 on September 4, 2017, declaring a state of emergency in all 67 counties within the State in response to Hurricane Irma; and

WHEREAS, On November 21, 2017, City Council approved Resolution 2017-102 authorizing a budget amendment to account for the expenses related to Hurricane Irma in FY17; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved Resolution 2018-91 on November 15, 2018, authorizing the additional expenses as a result of post storm recovery efforts that continued into FY18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

The City Council hereby authorizes the necessary budget amendment to account for the revenue received from FEMA in the fiscal year ended September 30, 2019, as a result of Hurricane Irma and Hurricane Michael as attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
