

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MILLER PIPELINE, LLC TO RELINE THE FOUR (4) 48" STORM CULVERT PIPES RUNNING UNDERNEATH THE PASADENA YACHT AND COUNTY CLUB GOLF COURSE; AUTHORIZING THE ASSOCIATED BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, There are four (4) 48" storm sewer pipes that run from Gulfport Boulevard through the Pasadena Place Subdivision and under the golf course in the Pasadena Yacht and Country Club; and ; and

WHEREAS, The pipes are corrugated metal installed twenty-four years ago and are corroding; and

WHEREAS, The proposed relining project will cost approximately \$200,000 less than the originally proposed plan using an open channel conveyance system; and

WHEREAS, This project was added to the Capital Improvement Budget for 2019/2020 and the City received a Senate Appropriation of \$300,000 for construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Miller Pipeline, LLC to reline the four (4) 48" storm culvert pipes that run underneath the Pasadena Yacht and Country Club Golf Course in the amount of \$376,137.50 using their existing Contract with the City of Orlando (IFB16-0007-4).

Section 2.

The City Council hereby authorizes the associated Budget Amendment as attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
