

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SMITH FENCE COMPANY FOR THE MARINA DRY BOAT STORAGE RENOVATION FENCING AND GATES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SURFACE SHELL FROM FLORIDA DIRT SOURCE FOR THE MARINA DRY BOAT STORAGE RENOVATION; AUTHORIZING AN ASSOCIATED BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Initial marina planning discussion and improvements began in January 2013, and City Council authorized the City Manager to allocate funds to enhance the amenities within the municipal marina complex over a period of budget years; and

WHEREAS, Projects completed include boatlifts, additional dry boat storage, kayak storage, marina parking lot paving, transient dock landscape project, aesthetic perimeter fencing, pump-out boat and land base pump-out machinery upgrades. The marina also installed 25 moorings and a 3,000 square foot building to accommodate our overnight guest and mooring field patrons; and

WHEREAS, The Dry Boat Storage Renovation will include shell base pervious surface, secured decorated fencing, two (2) automatic roll gates, water & electric, numbered spaces, security lighting, public parking for the proposed Marina's Living Shoreline Park and parking for south basin wet slip patrons; and

WHEREAS, The City can contract with Smith Fence Company for the Dry Boat Storage Renovation fencing and gates using the Pinellas County Blanket Purchase Order and purchase surface shell from Florida Dirt Source using State Contract pricing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA:**

### **Section 1.**

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Smith Fence Company for the Marina Dry Boat Storage fencing and gates in the amount of \$90,000.00 using the Pinellas County Blanket P.O. 430932, 431950 and authorizes the City Manager to purchase surface shell for the Marina Dry Boat Storage Renovation from Florida Dirt Source in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 using the Florida State Contract No.167-0390.

### **Section 2.**

The City Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment for the Marina Dry Boat Storage Renovation in the amount of \$150,000.00 as attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

### **Section 3.**

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
