

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT PHASE VI GRANT FROM THE EARLY LEARNING COALITION; AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SHADE SAIL FROM CREATIVE SHADE SOLUTIONS, INC.; AUTHORIZING AN ASSOCIATED BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City of Gulfport Recreation Center received a Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act-Phase VI Grant in the amount of \$38,076; and

WHEREAS, The funds will primarily be used to construct an outdoor classroom and eating area covered by a shade structure with a small portion of these funds being used for staff workforce development initiatives per a requirement of the grant; and

WHEREAS, The shade sail structure purchase includes engineering, permitting and installation and will be under a contract Creative Shade Solutions, Inc. has with Manatee County School Board Bid No. 21053-MR; valid through August 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, A budget amendment to recognize the grant proceeds and increase the associated expenditures in the amount of \$38,076 is required to accept this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to: accept Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act-Phase VI Grant proceeds from the Early Learning Coalition in the amount of \$38,076.00 to be utilized for the Recreation Center outdoor classroom and eating area with covered shade structure and to purchase of one (1) 30'x30' hip roof shade structure from Creative Shade Solutions, Inc. for a total amount of \$21,100, and does hereby approve the associated budget amendment as attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
